Catastrophic Injuries

This is defined as any condition in which a player's life is threatened or the player risks permanent impairment. Examples include, but are not limited to, respiratory or cardiac arrest, spine injuries and possible fractures.

In the event of a catastrophic injury, **Call 9-1-1.**

Be sure to have the following information:

- ▶ Name, address, telephone number of caller
- ▶ Number of players injured
- ▶ Condition of the player(s)
- ▶ First aid initiated by first responder

Emergency services access to fields

The L.O. Fire Department is likely to be on the scene rapidly since they are located less than a mile away. The football fields are north of the school's main building complex. Ambulance/fire department access is best achieved at the field level from Cloverleaf Road.

- ▶ From South Shore Boulevard (LOFD), head west and turn left on Greentree Road. (0.1 miles)
- ▶ Turn left onto Greentree Avenue (0.6 miles)
- ▶ Turn left onto Fernwood Drive (0.2 miles)
- ▶ Turn right onto Marjorie Avenue (100 yards)
- ▶ Turn right onto Cloverleaf Road (100 yards)
- ▶ Field access is open and obvious at this point.

The nearest hospital is the **Legacy Meridian Park Hospital**

- ▶ From Lakeridge High School, head east on Overlook Drive.
- ▶ Turn right onto Stafford Road (0.3 miles)
- ▶ At the roundabout, turn right onto Borland Road (1.5 miles)
- ▶ Shortly passed 60th Avenue, turn right into the hospital (1.9 miles)
- ▶ The emergency room is straight ahead at this point.
