Catastrophic Injuries

This is defined as any condition in which a student athlete’s life is threatened or the student athlete risks permanent impairment. Examples include, but are not limited to, respiratory or cardiac arrest, spine injuries and possible fractures.

Call 9-1-1.

Be sure to have the following information:

- ▶ Name, address, telephone number of caller
- ▶ Number of athletes injured
- ▶ Condition of Athlete(s)
- ▶ First aid initiated by first responder
- ▶ Specific directions to emergency scene:

1. Head north on SW 37th St toward SW Ladow Ave	0.2 mi
2. SW 37th St turns right and becomes Co 1305 Rd/SW Hailey Ave	0.8 mi
3. Turn left at SW Hailey Ave	0.1 mi
4. Turn left at Southgate/US-395 Continue to follow US-395	0.2 mi
5. Turn right at SW Frazer Ave/OR-37 Continue to follow SW Frazer Ave	0.4 mi
6. Turn left at SW 13th St	0.2 mi
7. Turn right at SW Dorion Ave/US-30 Continue to follow US-30 Destination will be on the right (<u>St Anthony’s Hospital</u>)	1.5 mi
